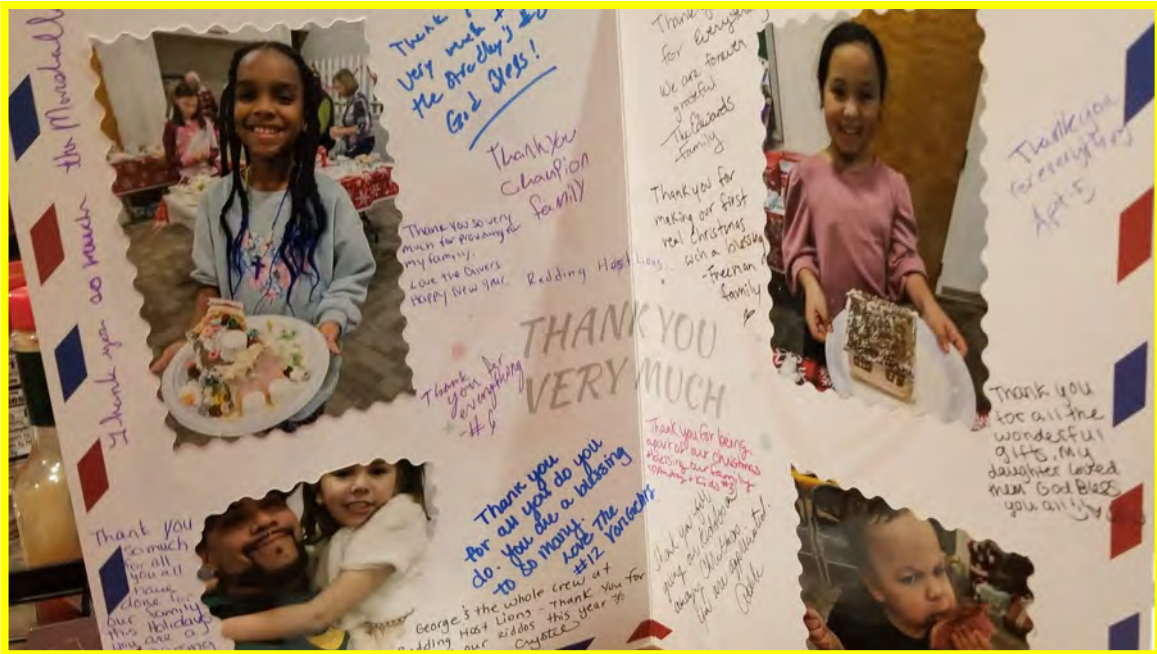

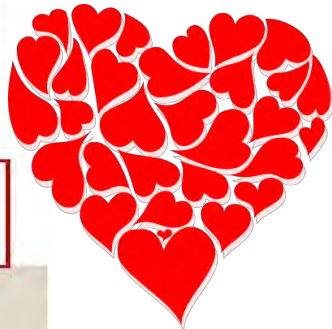

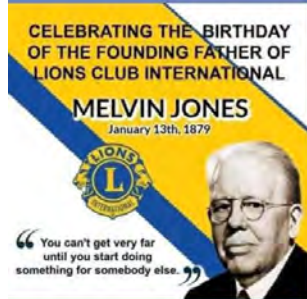
Thank you to Etna Lions for providing the trailer to be used to cover our vast North Region.
